- Various coverage disputes, including CGL policies and professional services policies on behalf of policyholders, including coverage for construction defects and faulty workmanship; and
- Seeking regulatory approval of multi-million dollar utility transactions.

He is also involved in multiple pro bono commitments, including criminal appellate work, the Marquette Volunteer Legal Clinic, and domestic abuse and truancy prevention.
